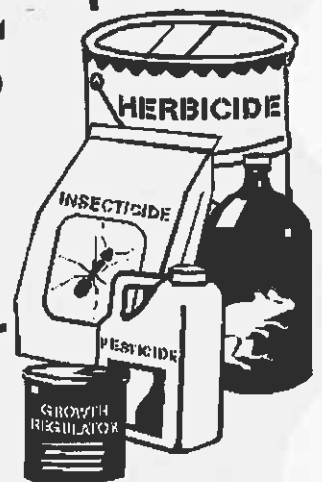

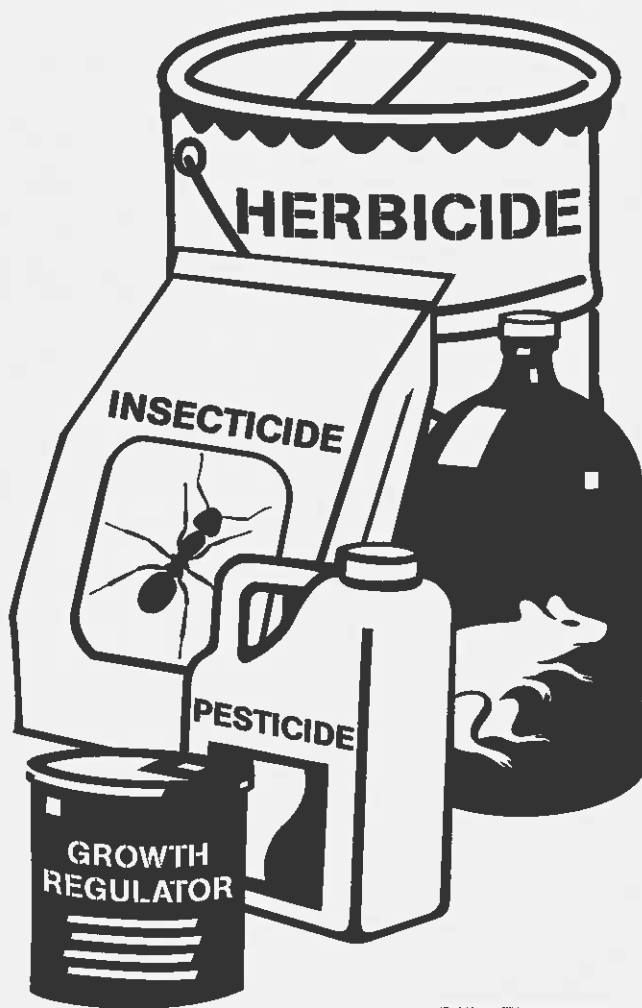

Online Tips to Do Your Part!

Do you have unwanted pesticides?

Bring them to one of these **free** collection events for proper disposal!



Open to Texas residents who:

- Apply pesticides or other agricultural chemicals for the production of agricultural products in Texas
- Have banned or unwanted agricultural chemicals

We **can** accept¹:

- Pesticides (including banned pesticides) such as:
 - Herbicides
 - Insecticides
 - Fungicides
 - Rodenticides
 - Nematicides
 - Bactericides
 - Pesticides used on livestock
 - Growth regulators
 - Harvest aid chemicals
- Gasoline/diesel fuel
- Transmission fluid
- Brake fluid
- Power steering fluid
- Anti-freeze
- Lead-acid batteries
- Oil/oil filters²/grease

¹ For quantities larger than a pickup truck load, please call 512-239-3143 or the county agent to ensure we are prepared to properly handle and accept the materials.

² Oil filters are limited to two (2) 55-gallon drums per participant.

For plastic pesticide containers,

please contact USAg Recycling at 1-800-654-3145 to arrange for a free pickup.

We **cannot** accept wastes from:

- Chemical dealers or distributors
- Chemical manufacturers
- School chemistry or biology labs
- Applicators regulated by the Texas Structural Pest Control Service
- Oil and oil filters from businesses that change oil for a fee

We **cannot** accept:

- Tires
- Propane/butane tanks larger than standard size (20-lb. capacity)
- Radioactive materials
- Explosive materials
- Fertilizers that are neither hazardous nor contain pesticide admixtures
- Nutrient materials that are neither hazardous nor contain pesticide admixtures
- Biomedical wastes
- Ammunition
